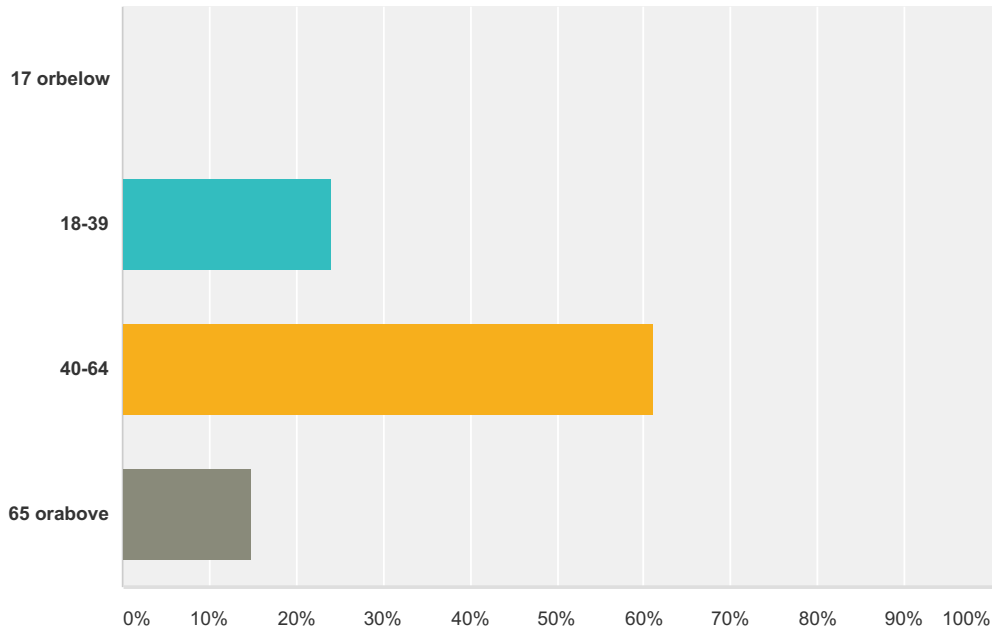


Q1 What is your age?

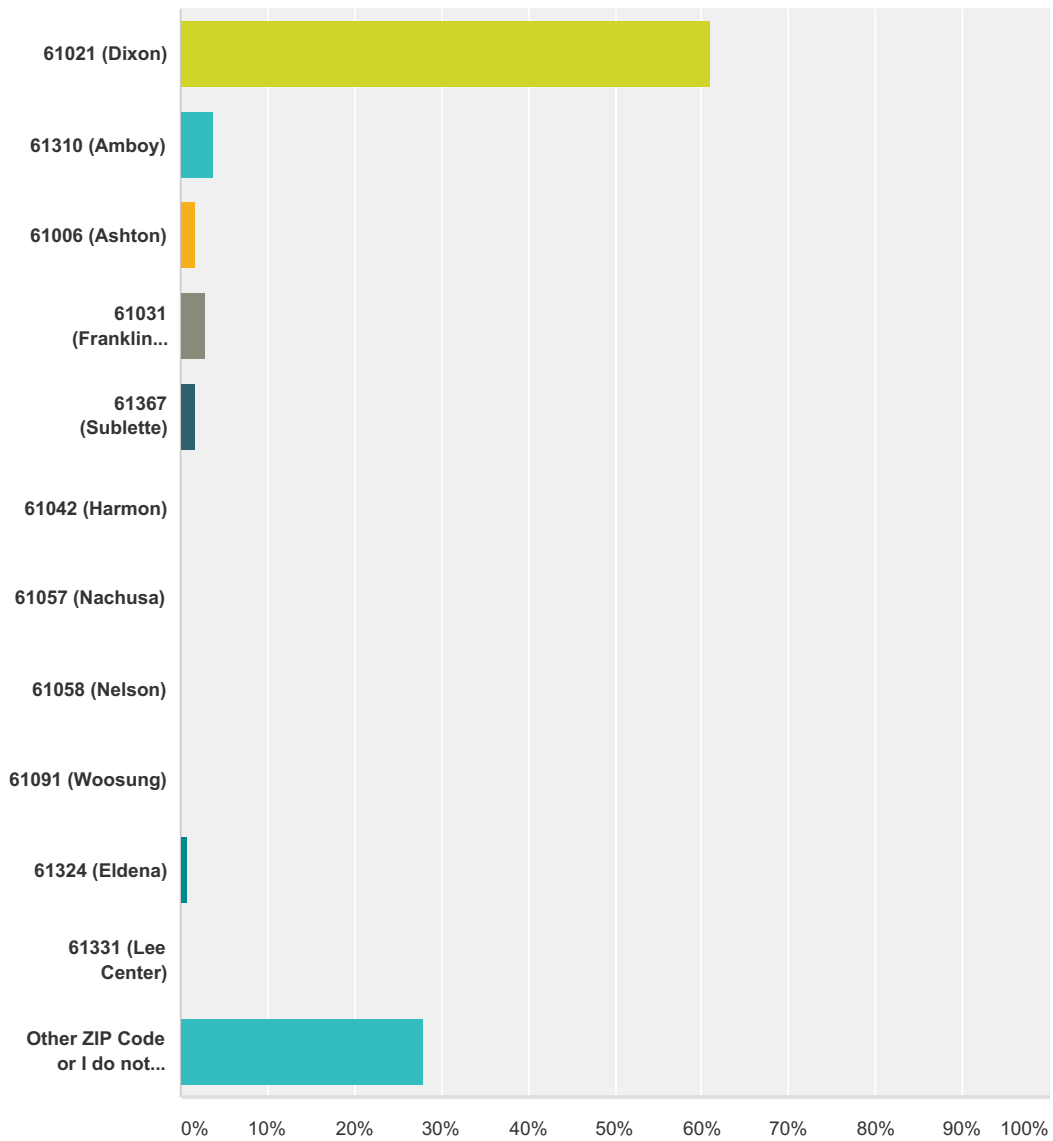

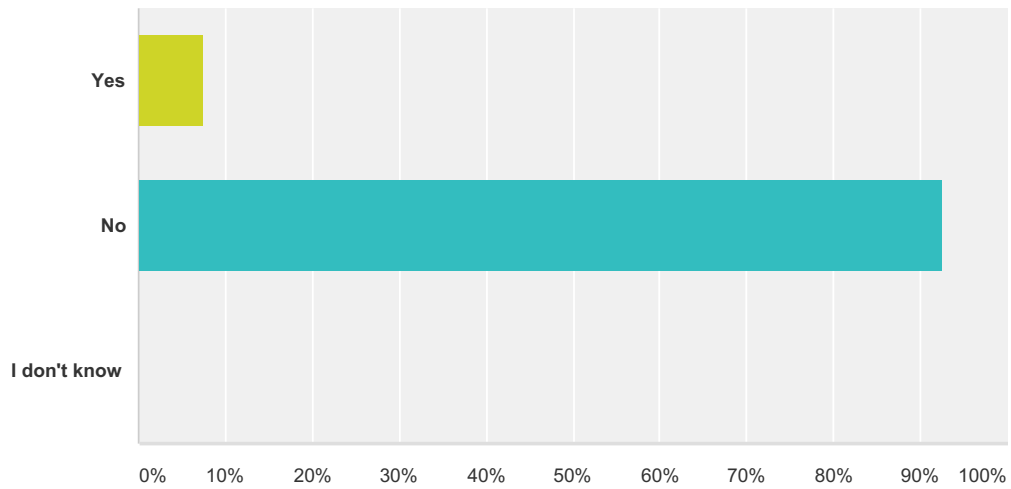

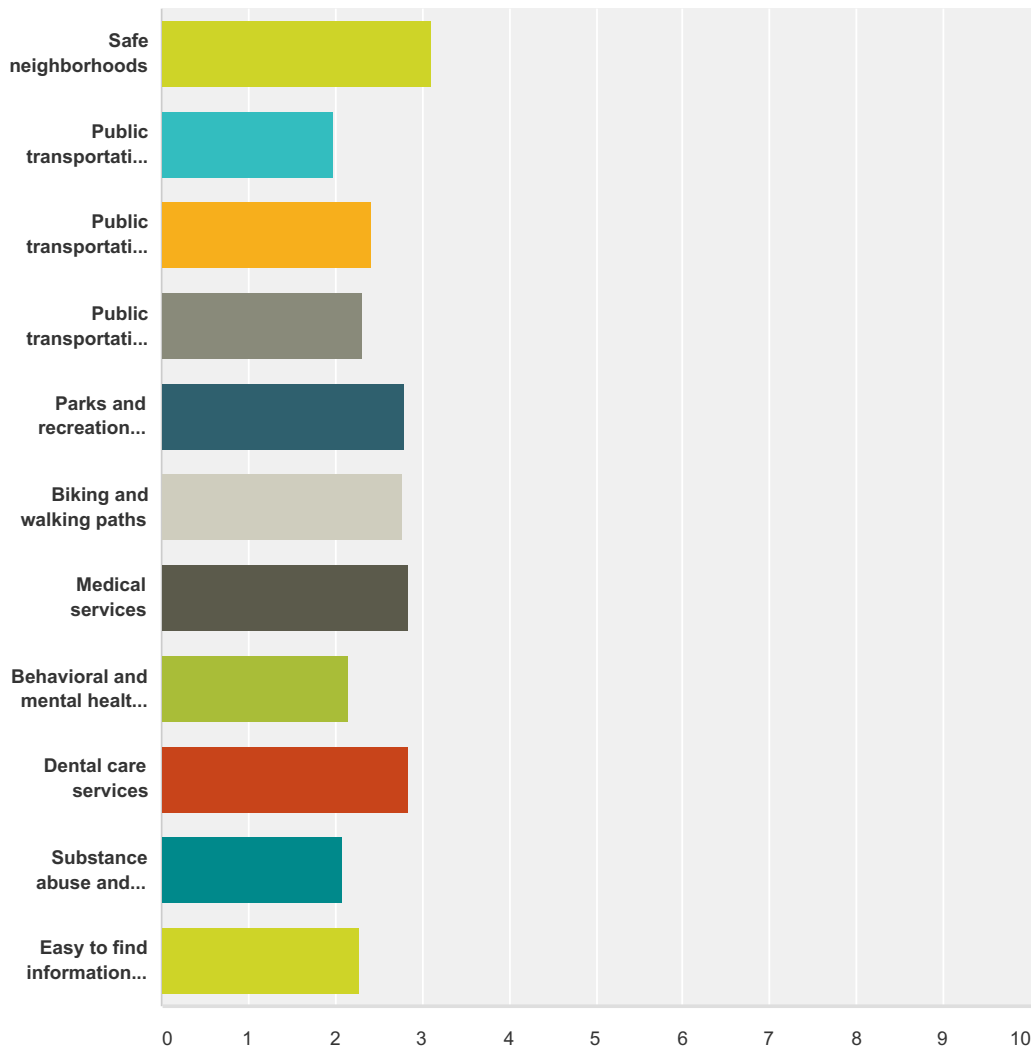

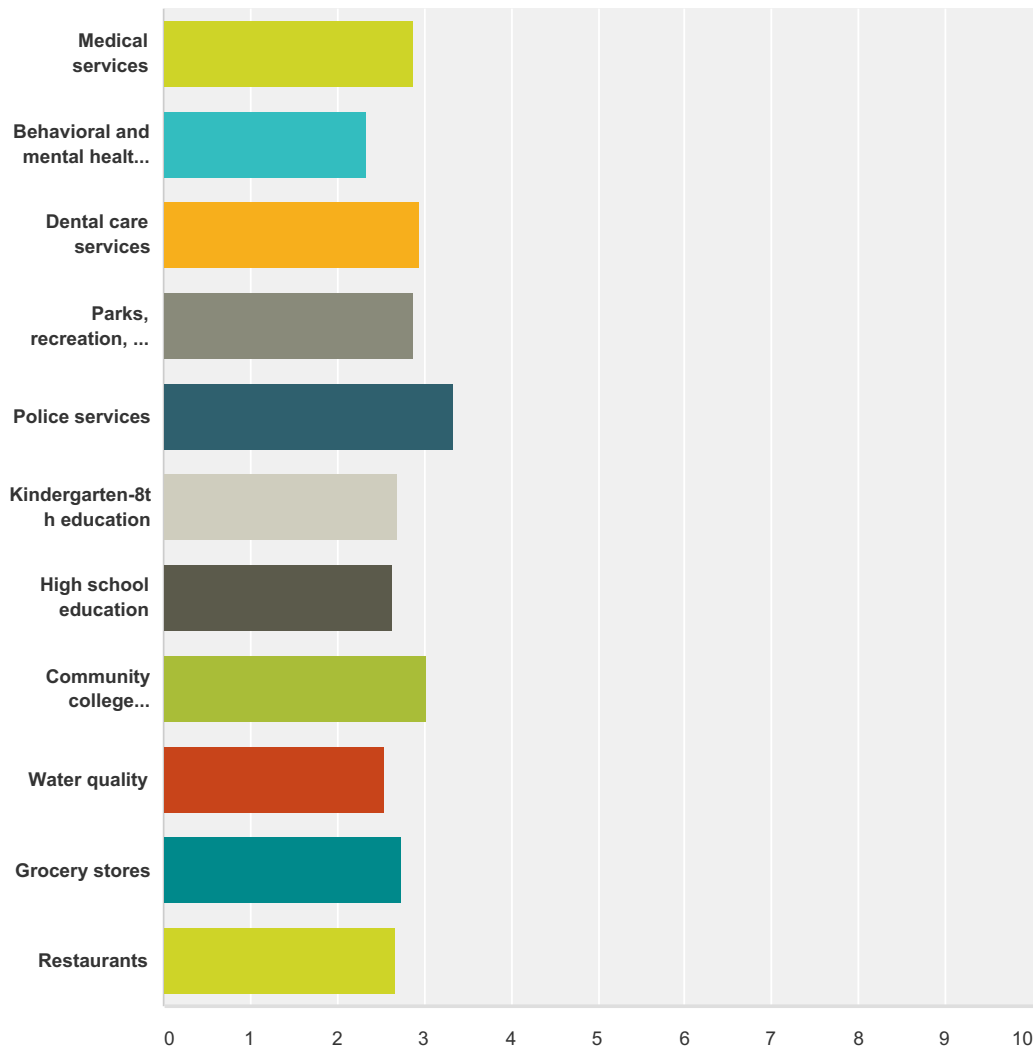

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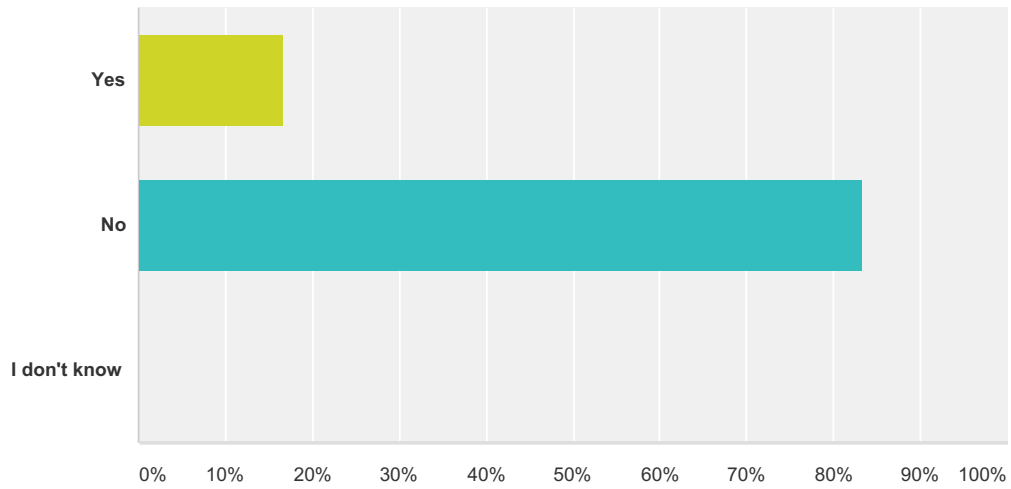

Q8 In the past year, have you or anyone in your household been unable to access or receive medical care?

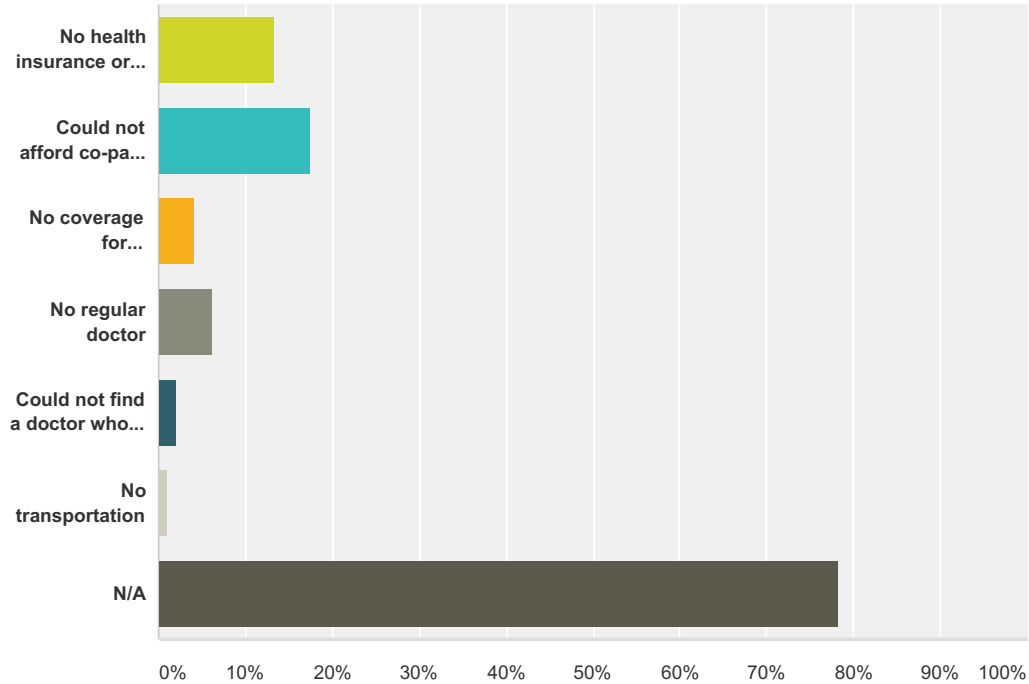
